El Paso, Texas- Local El Pasoan and UTEP graduate, MarySue Femath announces her candidacy for District 75 in the upcoming Democratic Primary.

MarySue was born and raised in El Paso's Lower Valley. She is a graduate of Del Valle High School and UTEP with a double major in Accounting and Finance. Upon graduation from UTEP, MarySue found herself in the education field when she left an accounting firm to become an Education and Library Program Coordinator.

She completed a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from University of North Texas and continues to help area students excel in their educational pursuits and create pathways to higher education.

"I believe that my district must have the tools to create healthy, educated and stable communities. The State must continue to support these initiatives not only in my district but in El Paso as a whole. My experience and commitment to education can contribute to the El Paso delegation's work in Austin and more importantly to House District 75 in El Paso's Lower Valley." said Femath.
