

Jared Woodfill named President of CRT

For decades, Jared Woodfill has consistently been on the front lines advancing conservative, Biblical values. I am proud to announce that he has been named President of **Conservative Republicans of Texas**.

Jared was elected to 6 terms as the Harris County Republican Party (HCRP) Chairman, making him the longest serving Chairman in Texas' largest county Republican Party. During his tenure, Jared raised over \$20 million, helped manage four county-wide electoral sweeps, presided over the greatest election cycle in HCRP history (2010) and led Harris County Republicans to record a record straight ticket vote of over 400,000 votes.

Jared has demonstrated himself to be an accomplished spokesman making hundreds of media appearances in Houston, Texas and across the country. He played an integral role in defeating the 2015 Houston Proposition 1 battle as the Campaign for Houston spokesman. If it had passed, then Proposition 1 would have allowed men to enter women's and girls' bathrooms, showers and locker rooms.

Jared practices law in Houston (Woodfill Law Firm, PC), where he frequently donates his legal services on behalf of conservative causes. Most recently, Jared successfully defended the pro-life champion, David Daleiden, who was wrongfully charged for his undercover investigation of Planned Parenthood in Houston for its role in the sale of aborted baby body parts. All charges against David were dropped.

Jared has been recognized for his commitment to our shared conservative beliefs. His awards include Texas Right to Life Horizon Award; Kelly Shackelford Award for Extraordinary Commitment to Faith Family and Freedom in Texas presented by Texas Values; Vision America Heroes of the Faith Award; Justice Foundation Defender of Life Award; JR Harris Best Supporting Role Award and the Texas Tea Party Republican Women Appreciation Award.
